

Dalham Village Hall Report 2020

The hall is currently closed due to the current pandemic. We do not know when we will be able to hold future events such as our regular monthly film nights and coffee mornings or when we will be able to take bookings for parties.

Prior to lockdown early in 2020 a new Keep Fit class started which was proving to be very popular with villagers. This class was established with the help of Fit Villages who surveyed the village to establish what sort of exercise activity would be supported. Once restrictions are lifted, I hope that we will be able to get this class up and running again.

During 2019 we had a high number of bookings for children's parties who enjoy the garden area around the hall. Many of these bookings have come from word of mouth and it is pleasing to see that we were also getting repeat bookings. Hopefully parties will be able to resume later this year.
