3. Reports:

a) Village Hall Report:

Chairman's Report 2022/2023 for the Dalham APM

This year has seen the hall receive an internal repaint, addition of brick paving to the rear of the Hall to allow the bins to be re-located away from the car park and new external lighting to replace the old units which had deteriorated. A grant of £1,600 (50% of the cost of the interior redecoration) was received from the Suffolk Council counsellor's locality budget.

We have held a number of very popular and successful events which have attracted new people to the Hall, these have included an October Wine Tasting, the November Festive Fayre, which generated proceeds of £1000, donated to St Mary's restoration fund, Mulled Wine and mince pies after the Carol Service, a Burns Night Dinner with singing and dancing, the return of Quiz Night, and most recently the Coronation Big Lunch.

Additionally, a pumpkin and sunflower growing competition was held along with inviting people to bring their apples to the hall to be crushed and pressed into juice at an apple day event.

We also produce a Village Calendar has again been a huge success with a large number of photos entered, and a good and rapid take-up of calendars which again sold out.

In addition to all these events we have seen good attendance at the regular Coffee Mornings held on the second Sunday of each month and fluctuating attendance at film nights where the popularity of the film has a huge impact on numbers.

As well as social events, the Hall continues to benefit the neighbourhood with weekly Keep Fit, Pilates and Boxing classes which are well attended and bring in regular income in addition to various private bookings for which reduced rates are available for villagers.

We look forward to another year with plenty of events being planned.
